JAKARTA, (Tubas) - Manager of PT Taman Impian Jaya Ancol Pembangunan Jaya Ancol Tbk (PJA) held an international art exhibition with a headline *Reconsidering Earth* for one month from Friday (8 / 7) until (8 / 8) at *Gallery North Art Space (NAS)*, Art Market, Ancol, North Jakarta.

A total of 35 artists from 20 countries joined in the *Olympia Fine Art Association (OFFA)* will enliven the exhibition.

President Director of PT Pembangunan Jaya Ancol, Budi Karya Sumadi describing the event as a form of commitment that management has an agenda to promote the Indonesian art in order to penetrate international markets. TRIBUNNEWS.COM JAKARTA - Jakarta Provincial Government in cooperation with the Ancol Dream Park will hold an international art exhibition in order to realize the 'Jakarta as the World Art Cities'.

According to Farida Rochani Kusuma, Program Manager and Event Development Dept Ancol Dream Park met Tribunnews explains, the exhibition contains a moral message that the earth and its environmental problems are attended by 35 artists from 20 countries joined in the Olympia Fine Art Association (OFAA) by displaying a variety of painting , a way to Video Art for a total of 73 works of art.
